



Looped and Knotted

Easy Washcloth Pattern

Perfect for beginners – quick, practical, and oh-so-satisfying!

Designed by Looped and Knotted

What You'll Need:

- Yarn: Worsted weight cotton yarn (like Lily Sugar'n Cream)
- Hook: 5.0 mm (H-8) crochet hook
- Extras: Yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker (optional)

Finished Size:

Approximately 8 x 8 inches, but easily adjustable!

Abbreviations (US Terms):

- ch – chain
- sc – single crochet
- st – stitch
- rep – repeat
- RS – right side
- WS – wrong side

Pattern Notes:

This washcloth is worked in rows using single crochet.

Feel free to add a border or stripe in a contrasting color!

Cotton yarn is perfect for durability and absorbency.

Instructions:

- Ch 31 (or any even number + 1 to adjust the width)
- Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (30 sc)
- Ch 1, turn.
- Rows 2–30 (or until square): Sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn.
- Final Row: Sc across.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.

Optional Border:

Join yarn at any corner, sc evenly around, placing 3 sc in each corner. Sl st to first sc to join. Fasten off.

Care Tip:

Machine washable. Lay flat or tumble dry low. Gets softer with each wash!
