



5 Projects to Make with Granny Squares

Simple, joyful ways to turn squares into something beautiful

💡 Why Granny Squares?

You've learned how to crochet a granny square (yay!), and now you're wondering: what do I do with them?

Good news — you don't need to make 100! Just a few can become something amazing. Here are 5 beginner-friendly, confidence-building ideas to get you started.

1. Granny Square Pouch or Bag

Use: 2–6 granny squares

Idea: Stitch 2 squares together for a coin purse, or 4 for a small tote

Tip: Add a fabric lining and a button or zipper if you want it secure

Perfect for: Yarn storage, travel, or a handmade gift

2. Cozy Neck Warmer or Scarf

Use: 5–10 squares (or more for a full-length scarf)

Idea: Seam squares in a row and add a border

Bonus: Mix colors or alternate solid + multicolor squares

Perfect for: Cold mornings, layering, or mindful gifting

3. Decorative Pillow Cover

Use: 4–16 squares, depending on pillow size

Idea: Seam squares into a front panel, then crochet or sew to a fabric back

Add: Buttons, tassels, or a bold border

Perfect for: Your couch, craft room, or as a housewarming gift

4. Table Runner or Wall Hanging

Use: 4+ squares in a row or grid

Idea: Choose a color palette and arrange for a modern, artsy look

Mount: Hang with a wooden dowel for a handmade wall feature

Perfect for: Decorating your craft space or gifting with love

5. Baby Blanket or Lapghan

Use: 20+ granny squares

Idea: Join into a large grid, add a wide border

Bonus: Use soft cotton or baby yarn for a gentle feel

Perfect for: Gifting to a new parent or cozying up with a book
